
have still have crappy heat, so team up with the guy with the new GT3!

Farewell to a Friend and 50 Year Metro Member

Long-time Metro Member, Chuck Hartley, passed peacefully after health complications related to dementia on December 5, 2021. He celebrated his 50 Year anniversary with Metro in December. His involvement in Metro spanned many decades.

The list of his titles held in the club is very extensive in just about every aspect of Metro's activities. Frequently accompanied by his wife Marilyn and his son John, his expertise in track, autocross, rally, concours, programs and the POST enabled him to mentor new members and he did so willingly and unselfishly. The following accolades tell his story and will give you an idea of the type of member Chuck was.

From Peter Portanova, Metro Past President, 1991: I met Chuck in 1984 when I joined PCA and attended DE events where he was my first instructor at Lime Rock and lead communicator for the track workers. He taught Adele and me how to manage the Tower responsibilities. We also worked together in the timing van during autocross events. We learned how to work checkpoints at the Snowflake Rally while meeting for breakfast. He never lost his Marine toughness, but had a big, kind heart. Chuck and I had another hobby in common; he was also an Amateur Radio Operator, call sign N2JIY. There he was very active and President of the Larkfield Amateur Radio Club of Huntington, NY for many years. You can now rest peacefully and run "Chucks Communications" in your new white van!

From Lenny Deutsch, Metro Past President, 1985-87: The most vivid picture I have of Chuck, is in my mind's eye; he is standing on the "extension" overlooking Lime

Rock, flag in hand, standing uniquely erect like on a Marine Sergeant could, always friendly and making sure that the events were run safely. Chuck was tall and when we spoke, he took eye-to-eye command. There was no end-run around Chuck Hartley. Many good memories were born at Metro events of which Chuck was a founding resource. Many of us stood on his shoulders to make those weekends indelible. Chuck was a rock in an (Metro Apple) pyramid.

From Don Coburn, Metro Past President, 1988-90-92-94: When I joined Metro in 1976, Chuck was always at the Executive Board meetings and I believe he was President in 1974. He also ran timing and scoring when Babs and I ran autocrosses at Floyd Bennett Field in Brooklyn and Chuck was always helping at Snowflake Rallies. When Metro first ran DE at Bridgehampton, we had to rent an RV so Chuck could run communications comfortably, it was that important to have him there. Marilyn contributed many "artist renderings" of P-cars that graced the cover of the POST. Chuck's son John also was big part of Metro, assisting Chuck and even taking on selling Metro Mart merchandise at events and timing and scoring at autocrosses, when taking a break from driving!

The Metro family sends heartfelt condolences to son John, his wife Maree and his Mom, Marilyn Hartley, grandson Peter and wife Andrea and their two-month old daughter Kathryn, all residing in the Austin, Texas area.



Track Ramblings

FRED PACK - DE INSTRUCTOR



You Really Should Try a Track Day With Your Porsche

Many of Metro's members participate in our DE (Driver Education) track events but very many more don't. Metro has almost 2,500 members, and mostly the same 50-100 people attend our DEs – along with 15-25 novices. This means that most members are

missing out! You should join the fun at a Metro DE day.

This column focuses on that much larger group – those who haven't taken themselves and their Porsche to a DE day. I want to start by proselytizing: If you haven't had your Porsche out on a race track you have been missing one of life's great joys – the fun, excitement, and thrill of driving on a track in your wonderful Porsche. I can only hope that my enthusiasm will cause readers who haven't had a track day to sign-up for a Metro DE event.

Things You Should Know

DE events are non-competition. You go at your own pace; no one will pass you unless you give them a signal that you are comfortable being passed at that moment.

<u>You will not be alone</u>. You will have a qualified instructor in the car with you to guide you throughout the event.

When are the DE events and how do I sign-up? The full Metro track schedule will soon be on the website (metronypca.org) and will be printed in the POST in enough time for you to register for events. The early season will be March 24-25 at New Jersey Motorsports Park, April 28-29 at Pocono (Tentative) and June 16 at Watkins Glen. Registration is done online at clubregistration.net.

Your Car.

Your Porsche is ready to hit the track if it has been properly maintained, with one possible exception (see below). You will not harm your Porsche in any way by driving it on the track! PCA requires that all DE entrants get their cars 'tech-ed' before each event. This is a no-cost technical inspection provided by some of

Metro's approved local Porsche dealers; or you can have it done by independent mechanics. Bring a blank copy of the Metro Tech Form (available on the Metro website in the DE section) to the inspection and be sure to have the shop fill it out and put their stamp on it. If you haven't had your car recently serviced I suggest that you take it to your dealer or regular shop for a going-over before taking it to the tech procedure. Your Porsche does not need any special parts or alignment or anything to give you a wonderful track experience. If it's in good shape it is ready to go. Remove the driver's side floor mat – this is a requirement: it might get tangled up with the gas pedal. The one exception to your Porsche being track-ready relates to convertibles: 911 Cabriolets must have a rollbar installed; Boxsters of the 986-type (2004 and older) need a rollbar extender (contact bkauto.com and perhaps other suppliers) unless you are pretty short [learn about the 'broomstick rule].

Guys and Dolls.

Very few women participate in DE events. A thought: If you are female and love your Porsche, consider attending a DE event. I predict that you will get hooked immediately.

What to bring.

You will need a helmet. Metro does have a few loaners so if you don't want to buy one yet, contact the Track Chair before the event for details. Helmets must be "Snell approved" and the sticker must say 2015 or 2020. Other than the helmet you don't need anything special. You'll have to wear long pants and a long-sleeve shirt. (Sometimes if it is very hot, short sleeves are permitted.) I strongly suggest sunglasses because it can get very bright on track. A folding chair is very useful. Bring water. Be sure to bring coats, sweatshirts, etc if it seems like it might be cold. Track events start early each day – usually 7am – so it may be quite cold. Be prepared for rain.

The most important thing. The most important thing is to relax and let yourself have fun. There is a lot going on at a track day and the track experience is very intense, so it's easy to get stressed. Your instructor and the class sessions you'll attend will tell you what you need to know out on the track in order to have a safe and fun time. My next column will discuss some track driving basics to get you ready for your exciting First Day at the Track.

Be On Time

JEFF GOLDBERG - RALLY CHAIR



The 66th consecutive running of the Snowflake Rally took place on February 6, 2022. We were extremely lucky because less than one week before, Long Island was hit with a blizzard that dropped 18"-24" of snow on the route used in this Snowflake Rally. While the Snowflake Rally has encountered snow storms that began during the rally, according to our records, we

never had to postpone or cancel the Snowflake Rally in 66 years.

First I want to thank Henry Hoeh and Dan Fishkind for helping me create the route for this Snowflake Rally. As a team we drove the route 10 times. Setting up a rally not only includes creating a route, but also using equipment to accurately measure the mileages of every turn and feature many times. Also, special thanks to Karen Ohland who proofread the route, checked the result calculations and the General Instructions. It was great to have someone with so much rally experience. Karen helped Ted and Nancy Ohland for many years running the Snowflake Rally.

I also want to thank the following people who worked checkpoints. Paul Celentano, Adam Fox, Bob & Karen DeMotta, Mitch Hackett, Jennifer Filippelli, Barbara Kasa, Erik & Lisa Ohland. Checkpoint workers sit in their cars all day watching for rallyist to pass. They are responsible to record the car number and the exact time the car passes a predetermined spot on the road. Rallies are scored by one point for every second plus/minus when

the car misses the exact time they are expected to pass the checkpoint. The results of the event are dependent on their accuracy.

This year we tried out an electronic scoring system created for rallies. Participants installed a special app into their IOS or Android device. The app records the time they passed the checkpoint. At the end of the rally the Rally Master is able to download a scoresheet that tallied the scores for all cars. I admit there was a learning curve using the app for the first time but it was worth it. That was an additional challenge this year, but it will be better each time we use it. Using the app's scoresheet we had the results in less than one hour. I know it will not take as long next time. In year's past, totaling the results manually took 2-3 hours. In addition to faster results, by using this app it will no longer be necessary to have volunteers sitting in their cars mid-winter for many hours. Many PCA and SCCA Regions have been successfully using this app for a few years. In fact, it will be used at this year's Porsche Parade.

Congratulations to everyone who participated in this year's Snowflake Rally. The team of Hugo Brunert and Ken Hargreaves won overall First Place in an equipped car from the Expert Class with a score of 48.6 points. Rally computers definitely make a difference. In the Tour Class, Marc and Andrew Lemchen took First Place with 583.5 points.

Once again, due to COVID, we met outside at a Park & Ride for the finish instead of in a restaurant. A number of participants waited and drove home with their trophies. Trophies were mailed to the other winners. Hopefully the world will be in a better place by next year and we will meet in a restaurant for the finish.

Musings from the Barn Find Hunter

Metro NY Porsche Memories

When Mitch Hackett asked me to write a story for the Metro NY Porsche Club, my initial thought was to give the back story of some of the Porsches I have discovered on my YouTube program, Barn Find Hunter. But as I began to write the piece, I realized that I actually had a few personal Long Island Porsche stories, having spent the first three decades of my life there. I hope you enjoy them.

My mother was born in Germany and immigrated to the United States after World War II. She had grown up in a privileged household in the eastern German city of Breslau. Her father, my Opa, was a successful businessman whose passion was collecting cars. My mother told me that in the 1930s he owned not only Mercedes-Benzes and Porsches, but he loved American cars and owned a Chrysler and a Ford, among others. I guess this is where I inherited my automotive chops. Her family was lucky to escape from the advancing Russians with their lives, but they never again saw their beloved car collection.

My mother met my father, a U.S. Soldier, at Rhein-Main Air Force Base near Frankfort. They eventually married and my Dad took a job with Republic Aircraft on Long Island. And like most post-war families, they started having kids, starting with me, in 1954.

Mom and Dad bought a small house in Holbrook for \$7,000, and even though money was tight, they bought a brand new VW Beetle in 1957 from Bianco Motors in Sayville, which was one of the first VW franchises on Long Island.

The service manager at Bianco was Oscar Rubio, who became friendly with my parents over the years as they upgraded to a new VW every couple of years. Oscar eventually decided to leave Bianco to open a Porsche dealership, Competition Imports, with his friend Joe Buzzetta., Competition Imports was located on Smithtown Avenue in Smithtown. My parents decided to follow Oscar and have their VWs serviced next to a bevy of 356s.

When I was a kid, I didn't realize that Joe Buzetta was an internationally known Porsche race driver and Oscar Rubio had been his crew chief.

I was just a small kid, probably 5 or 6 years old, but already car crazy. Even though I was mostly attracted to hot rods

and dragsters with big V-8 engines, I was intrigued with the race cars stored in Competition Imports' service department. Porsche 904s and 906s, if I remember the shapes correctly 60 years later. This many years later I remember tapping on the racing tires with my small fist, which produced a satisfying bong-bong sound. Oscar once allowed me to sit in one of the cars, a 904. And once in a while, Oscar would present me with a gift, a small Wyking toy, a tiny Porsche, or VW plastic toy that was made in Berlin.

This was my first exposure to Porsches.

A couple of years later my parents had a chance to buy a black 356 coupe from a doctor friend of my father's for what was supposedly a good price, but they decided against it, purchasing another Beetle instead.

In the 1960s, my mom got a job at Brookhaven National Laboratory, "BNL", on the site of the former World War I Camp Upton Army Base. It was located on William Floyd Parkway north of Mastic, and a 25-minute commute from our house in Holbrook. BNL was almost a self-contained city, comprised of hundreds of acres, and dedicated to secret nuclear research. My mother worked the night shift, 4 PM to midnight, and sometimes after school I'd go to work with her because there were lots of cool things for a kid to do. There was an indoor swimming pool, gymnasium, and miles of roads to ride bicycles. There were also apartments, housing for the scientists and physicists who lived there on a short-term basis. I remember seeing British, Italian, and German sports car projects parked behind the apartment buildings. BNL had a sports car club, and with many of the Laboratory staff participating in road races at the nearby Bridgehampton Race Circuit, or in gymkhanas and rallies.

I remember once reading in the classified ad section of the Laboratory's weekly newsletter that one of the physicists, a Porsche enthusiast, was offering a free Speedster to anyone who would haul it away. Apparently, he was moving and had to clear the parking lot of his projects before vacating.

This was about 1972, so I was about 18 or 19 and really into VWs and Karman Ghias.

I was also into barn finds, although that term had not yet been invented. As soon as I read the ad, I jumped into my VW and made a beeline to see what was being given away.

A month or two earlier I responded to a similar ad for a free 1960 Karman Ghia, sans engine, which turned out to be a real solid gem. I hoped this Porsche might be in similar condition, but as I pulled into the parking lot, my hopes were dashed. Here was a rusty, sagging Speedster without a top, and obviously exposed to the elements for many years. I couldn't even open the doors because the car had rusted so badly that they were pinned shut. I popped open the engine lid and it was empty. It was a parts car at best.

Of course today that car would be restored and turned into a Concours winner, but 50 years ago it was a rusty piece of junk. I said no thanks and instead satisfied my sports car desires with a red 1969 MGB.

Decades later, having moved off Long Island to pursue a career in racing, I moved to Charlotte, N.C. and first became PR director at Charlotte Motor Speedway, then opened Cotter Group, a motorsport marketing and communications agency. And as time allowed, I took up road racing again at Southeastern tracks such as Roebling Road in Savannah, Road Atlanta and Summit Point in West Virginia. Most tracks in the South have quiet hours on Sunday mornings in respect to area churches, and it was during one of those quiet hours that I was walking with my young son, Brian, through the paddock looking at the quiet race cars. Brian was probably 3 or 4 years-old at the time, so I held his hand and explained to him that "This car is a Formula Vee, and that car is an Alfa Romeo," etc.

When we arrived at Porsche 904 in daily-driver condition, I had to stop. It had been so long since I'd been in the presence of a car like this. I explained to Brian that the very first race car I had ever sat in as a little boy was a car like this, and I lifted him up to peek in the windows.

I must have been fairly animated because within a few moments a very tall man approached. "You seem to be pretty excited about this car. Would you like your son to sit in it?"

I said yes, and as Brian played race driver in the rare Porsches' driver's seat, the car's owner, Henry Paine, introduced himself. He told me that he regularly used this 904 as his commuter car between the race track and the

hotel. He said he owned a collection of fiberglass Porsches:

906, 908, etc. that he vintage raced. But this 904 was his street driver. I was impressed.

When I lifted Brian out of the car, I hesitantly asked Henry if I could sit in it. He said, "Sure," but gave me instructions on how to do it correctly. "The floor is made of thin fiberglass, so you can't put your weight on it or it will break," he said. "One hand on the transmission tunnel and the other on the doorsill and you can swing your legs in."

I followed his instructions and within moments I was sitting in the driver's seat without damaging the floor of this fragile

As I sat there, I mentioned to Henry that this was the second 904 I had sat in during my life. The first time was as a small child, just a little older than Brian.

"Might you remember whose car you sat in," he asked?

"Yes, it was Joe Buzzetta's at Competition imports, where my parent VW was serviced," I said.

Henry was silent for a moment, and then said, "I bought this car from Joe."

Then I was silent for a moment. The first race car I had sat in was also the first race car my son had sat in decades later. You can't make this stuff up.


Over the years, I've been exposed to numerous Porsches. Having spent a career in the racing industry, I had spent quite a bit of time around 935s and 962s when they were dominating the IMSA circuit. I was there when Bob Akin crashed his Coca-Cola 962 while entering Charlotte Motor Speedway's road course in the 1986 Camel GT. And I've been a lifelong fan of Hurley Haywood, Al Holbert, John Paul, Jr., and that whole gaggle of drivers who entertained us with great racing during IMSA's amazing "Pharmaceutical" years.

Since then I've owned a nice 356 C and a 997, but I never veered very far from my childhood infatuation with rumbling V-8s, so my true automotive passion is AC Cobras, Shelby Mustangs, and, yes, hot rods.

But I can't help but imagine how my life might have taken a different tack if that free Speedster had been a solid car.






my word to do my best to deliver quality drives and events that, of course, are with the help of you good people. I believe in the power of togetherness!






