Skid reMarks DAN FISHKIND - AUTOCROSS CHAIR



You never thought it would come, but the 2023 Metro New York Region Autocross Series is days away! The schedule is a good one this year and we will be at Tobay Beach later than ever so we can hope for some nice weather. Tobay events will be March 5th, 19th, April 8th and 23rd. Please note that if you have already seen the autocross flyer, the April dates have changed from the original

flyer. These are the correct dates. After Tobay Beach we head over to the Nassau Coliseum for a few months and then back to Tobay Beach for October and November.

If you modified your cars, I hope everything went well. I am sure we will see some new tires, suspensions, engine and exhaust modifications as well as seats and harnesses on the course this year. If you did complete some modifications be careful of what you did to the car as your modifications might change the class you are in. Read the autocross rules carefully so there are no surprises. Car modifications are not necessary to have a great time at autocross. As you advance and get more involved then it's always fun to do things to the car to enhance your autocross experience however, these cars are great right out of the box so don't hesitate to get involved with your stock vehicle. Although, the best mod you can make is you...the driver. There is nothing more important than improving your driving skills. How do you do that, you ask? You do that by seat time, seat time, seat time! Have I mentioned there is no substitute for seat time? The most important weapon you have in your car is you, the driver. Come down to all events and you will watch yourself improve. If you are new to the sport, your goal would be to better your times on each run. As you improve, you can start looking at other drivers' times in your class and compete against them. That is what's so great about Autocross, there is competition at every level. An added bonus of autocross is that it helps you on the street as well as you will learn how your car reacts in certain situations which translates to better and safer street driving. Additionally, if you are considering getting involved with our Driver's Education Program (track driving), then autocross is a great way to experience your car at its limit, at a slower safe speed so you will get used to how your car will react at faster track speeds. Autocross is a great prerequisite for track driving.

Now back to autocross. As usual, I am also looking for autocross course designers. If you would like to try your hand at designing a course let me know. If you're unsure what that entails, come volunteer for a course setup and see what it takes. Please let me know if you are interested in helping out. I also have some course design information.

Just a note, March 4th will be the annual Autocross Seminar and Mini School which starts at the Haypath Road Park Community Room in the morning and then moves to Tobay Beach for the afternoon. If you are reading this before the event and you are signed up, please note that the seminar has changed to the Haypath Road Park FROM the Bethpage Community Park. If you did not attend the school, please don't let this discourage you from participating in our regular events. All our events are newbie friendly and there are many great guys who are willing to make you feel comfortable and help you out with the sport. There is no reason to be intimidated. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.

We have a great schedule this season. In addition to local events, the Zone 1 Autocross will be held in Ayer, Massachusetts on a decommissioned Army Airforce Base. This makes for a great track and loads of fun driving. It will be on August 26th and 27th and besides some great driving it is a great social event with a catered dinner Saturday night and team awards. You won't want to miss this.

As far as pricing this year, unfortunately we have had to raise prices bit. The PCA member price is \$45 and non-member price is \$55. A surcharge of \$10 will be added for onsite registration if you register at the event.





Track Ramblings FRED PACK - DE INSTRUCTOR



Typically each year during the cold winter months I run 1 or 2 columns designed to get Metro members who have not had their Porsches on a racetrack to try a Metro DE event. This year I am not running those articles because the April Porsche Panorama will have a comprehensive article on the subject jointly written by me and Mia Walsh, the PCA National Driver Education Chairperson. I urge Metro

people who haven't had any track experience to read the article and also promptly sign up for a Metro DE event. The full 2023 schedule is available on the Metro website. As Mia and I said in the article, "Your car wants to be on track; your car needs to be on track; you need to be on track." It's what your Porsche is all about. You have a thoroughbred and are punishing it and yourself if you keep it in the barn.

Since I'm not recycling my old winter articles this year, I had to come up with other things to write about. One of them is to urge readers to take advantage of the winter season to have their Porsches gone over thoroughly by your dealer or indie shop. This is a good opportunity to have the wheel bearings and other "2nd-tier" areas checked. Years ago I had a wonderful Watkins Glen event ruined by a failed wheel bearing and I've twice had to leave DE events early when the gearshift cable sheared off. Avoid mishaps like that by giving your car thorough Preventive Maintenance, and of course, you should change the oil and brake fluid in your car regularly. I spend my winters in Vail, Colorado, where I ski just about every day. This year my son came out to be with me on my birthday in December. He is an excellent skier, but he had a mishap in deep, heavy snow on the first run of his first day of the season - he tore his ACL and needed surgery. Consequently, my wife and I spent a lot of time in the Vail hospital, which is one of the best orthopedic hospitals in the world. Athletes, dancers, celebrities, and F1 drivers come here to get patched up. The hospital walls are lined with their photos. Attached to this article is one of these photos of someone who should be quite familiar to most POST readers.

Somewhat off-topic is a subject that has been on my mind lately, having to do with electric cars. I have driven a few because I get invited to automotive journalist driving opportunities, and I can say that they are truly magnificent. I think that people's quite legitimate "range anxiety" will diminish over the next few years as better batteries will be providing more range, and more charging stations will be available. What concerns me for the long run is the overall demand on the nationwide (and worldwide) electric grid as more and more e-cars will be requiring more electricity than perhaps the grids can supply. We are seeing not-infrequent brownouts even now when electric vehicles account for only 5% of current sales. I did some Googling and learned that there are 1.4 billion cars worldwide, of which about 30 million are electricpowered, which works out to about 2%. Will there be enough electricity to go around when that figure is 30% or 70%? Happy Motoring!





I am working on dates to get on the calendar for Pancake & Porsche events in the near future.



Tribute to Joe Buzzetta BILL RUDTNER - CHIEF INSTRUCTOR



Back in the late 70's when I started my professional career as an auto-mechanic I was working at BMW dealerships. As time goes on you make different friends the field and people get to talking. The rumor mill was that dealership best to work was Competition Imports. That dealership and other dealerships going by the prefix of Competition were

owned by a guy named Joe Buzzetta. Joe was the kind of business proprietor that cared about his employees. I never worked for Mr. Buzzetta but I knew of him in other ways.

When Joe was a young man Joe's father owned a restaurant in Centerport called Bella Vista. After Joe's stint in the Army, he worked there as a bartender. There was many a weekend where car club guys would congregate in the parking lot of the restaurant. Oscar Rubio was a patron at Bella Vista who owned an Autorepair shop called Competition Engineering. Oscar and Joe became friends and decided to go into business together. Although Joe's father wasn't happy about Joe leaving the restaurant business he did lend him the money needed to finance his dream.

In the beginning, he and Oscar began by selling used cars. Joe developed a relationship with Max Hoffman and thus the first dealership deal for Joe was solidified. In 1970 Mercedes-Benz contacted Joe and another dealership was soon born. Today there are many "Competition" titled dealerships throughout Long Island owned by the Buzzetta family.

In my early days with our Porsche club, I heard of a small Metro PCA club meeting that was being held at a museum of sorts behind a Mercedes dealership in Smithtown. This Mercedes dealership was one of the many Buzzetta dealerships. In the back was a beautiful building that was home to many of Joe's early race cars and more of his car collection. This was when I first became aware of Joe

Buzzetta. Just to mention a few of Joe's cars, I remember distinctly seeing a 904, a 906, and a 908 along with my lifetime favorite (although not a Porsche) a Ferrari 512bbi. The 906 was driven by Joe at the 12 hours of Sebring where he placed 4th overall and 1st in class. The 904 was driven by Joe with Gerhard Mitter at Daytona where they placed 1st in class and 7th overall. Joe drove the 908 with Dick Attwood at Daytona. Joe stated that "This 908 is an important car as it won the Monza 1,000 kilometer race driven by Jo Siffert and Brian Redman."

Joe's competitive spirit came from a long career in Auto racing that started in the 50's when he was stationed in Germany with the Army. His success as a competitive driver led Porsche to offer Joe a seat. Joe was the first American driver to drive for the Porsche factory. He held a position as a Porsche factory driver from 1966 through 1970. Joe's most exciting moment was in 1967 when he crossed the finish line in first place while racing the Nurburgring in Germany. That day Joe Buzzetta had given Porsche the overall win in over a decade. After Joe's professional career in Auto racing, he went on for another 25 years racing in the Vintage racing series. Joe's flare for business is undeniable as well.

Joe is a man that is held in high regard by many. Certainly, a man I look up to. It is needless to say that Joe Buzzetta will be strongly missed by many. Joe Buzzetta passed away on January 15th. May he rest in peace.



Let's Get Technical MATTHEW KAMMET - TECH CHAIR



Hello, Metro region. For those of you who do not know me already I'd like to take a moment to introduce myself. First off you all can call me Matt, I believe in using full names when in print. I've been working on mostly German cars and SUVs for close to 20 years. Although I got my start with Audi and Volkswagen, I have enioved working on Porsches the most for the last nine years.

Now let's talk tech. AutoX season is around the corner and I have noticed that since there is no official tech inspection for these events, participants tend to know less about their cars and what stresses they endure than say those who are active in our driver education events. Believe it or not, it is just as important to have your cars checked over for AutoX. Even though these events are typically held in areas that are open and at slower speeds, vehicles are put through just as much punishment. You are dealing with short, hard braking periods and rapid speed and directional changes. Let's have a look at a few areas.


Brakes: In AutoX you are dealing with some very quick hard braking to allow you to make sharp turns. This can be very punishing. The rapid changes in temperature can cause several things to happen. One is warping rotors. You may find that after a hard event on the way home, your steering wheel shakes when you apply the brakes. What has happened is the hard braking has caused the metal of the rotor to heat and cool at different rates causing them to deform. With tolerances the way they are on modern cars it's likely that the only remedy is to have them replaced. Something that often gets overlooked is the brake fluid. You may also find that after an event your brake pedal feels a bit squishy or it takes longer than expected to stop. What has likely happened is you boiled your brake fluid and there is gas in the system. Since gas can compress you lose the solid feeling of a good brake pedal. I would recommend having the brake fluid replaced with one that can handle a higher temperature before boiling.

Bushings: Since AutoX tends to be more accessible to the public, many participants use unmodified or even daily-driven vehicles to make their way through the cones. Rapid directional changes can cause extra stress on factory rubber bushings. This type of bushing is used in production vehicles to reduce road noise and increase ride comfort. They are not really meant to be flexed so hard and so frequently. If your vehicle feels like it's not really holding the pavement well it might be because these bushings have torn creating a loose connection between you and the road. In many cases with European cars, the only remedy is the replacement of entire control arms. In some cases, just the bushing can be replaced but the difference in price point usually makes it worthwhile to just replace the entire arm.

Tires: AutoX is very punishing on your tires. The extreme angles often cause factory aligned cars to roll the edge of the tire. You will find that the outer edge and possibly even the sidewall wear down faster than the rest of the tire. Wear on the sidewall is a bad thing and should be checked by a professional as soon as possible. A new tire may be recommended as well as a more competitive alignment if you decide to continue competing.
